Adopted October 19, 2003

Need for Comprehensive Screening in Contaminated Areas

The Conference emphasizes the urgent need to conduct a comprehensive screening of DU contamination in Iraq and Afghanistan including all environmental elements (water, air, soil) and other human health aspects. It is recognized that it is the responsibility of the UNEP and WHO to conduct these assessments on DU contamination. They shall be expected and held accountable to conduct these and other necessary investigations in a meaningful timeframe, and publish and make available *unaltered* by other bodies, governments and agencies such as the IAEA the findings of these investigations to the public.

Epidemiological studies should be also started with full medical investigation of people in contaminated areas, including but not limited to: investigations of DU-related analyses in urine, tissue biopsy and chromosomal and cytogenetic studies. Treatment of previously and currently affected people including medicine and medical aids is highly required.
